

Volunteer Hours requirements and expectations

The East Manatee Bulldog organization is a non-profit organization and is heavily dependent upon volunteer participation. As such, we attempt to offer our programs at the best value possible. Because of this, we rely on our parents to volunteer and assist with certain function that are needed by the league throughout the year. The volunteer opportunities will be posted and made available to sign up for as the season draws near.

The expectation for each child in our league is that a family member or high school age sibling will contribute at minimum 10 hours of volunteer time. These hours are tracked throughout the season. If at the end of the regular season, by the last home game, the commitment of 10 volunteer hours has not been fulfilled, the league will be expecting a payment of \$250. We will be collecting payment methods for this \$250 at the start of the season when gear is handed out. Credit card or checks will be accepted for this. The payments will be processed at the earliest possible time after the end of the season. All others who meet the volunteer obligation will have the check or credit card payment information voided and destroyed. If you would like to opt out of the Volunteer hours and donate \$250 you may do so at any time. For any families that have more than 1 participant, the volunteer hours required are 15 hours total per family or the buyout amount is \$375 total per family.
